MAY TUITION, TUITION DEPOSIT AND APRIL/MAY LUNCH BUNCH INVOICES

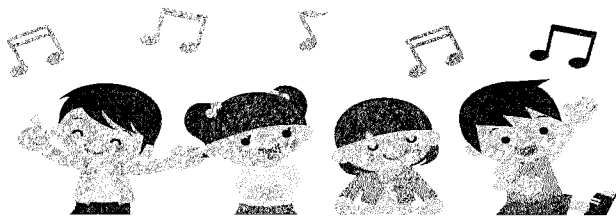
Many of you made your last tuition payment for 2021-2022 in April. You will not owe any further tuition payments for this school year (unless we notified you individually).

If your child stayed for Lunch Bunch in April or May, we will combine your charges for April and May. Since there are just a few weeks left in the Lunch Bunch program, we will send one bill, on or around May 10, that covers your child's Lunch Bunch stays for both April and May together.

As you may remember from registration and the enrollment agreement that was signed and turned in as part of registration, a tuition deposit equal to the first month's tuition is due for ALL returning students (2s, 3s, PreK) by May 10th. This tuition deposit is nonrefundable and shows your commitment to our school for next year. Once collected this deposit will ensure that your child has a spot on a class list for next school year.

School closes at NOON every day Tuesday, May 10 – Wednesday, May 18

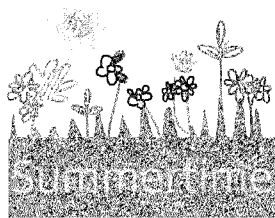
